INVESTING IN THE COMMUNITY

Founded in 1969, ArtsFund has distributed more than \$71 million dollars in grants to King and Pierce County arts groups, including \$2.55 million in 2014. Investing in a wide range of the arts community, including large and small organizations across all disciplines, ArtsFund ensures broad access to diverse artistic, educational and outreach programming. Because ticket sales only account for half of an arts organization's operating budget, ArtsFund's respected grants are vital to the health and sustainability of the region's cultural sector.
