#### GRANT

Your single donation is leveraged through ArtsFund's trusted allocations process, which awards annual grants to a broad range of regional cultural organizations. In 2017, 58 grantees received \$2.4 Million in operating support. Since 1969, ArtsFund has awarded over \$79.1 Million in grants to over 100 organizations.

### LEAD

Our grants and programs make cultural nonprofits stronger, more stable, and strategic. We also train the next generation of nonprofit leaders and arts advocates through our **Board Leadership Training**, Cultural Partners Network, Convenings, and other programs.
