WHAT WE DO

For nearly 50 years, ArtsFund has strengthened the Puget Sound community by partnering with individuals and businesses to support the arts. Join us in making a difference.

GRANT

Your single donation is leveraged through ArtsFund's trusted allocations process, which awards annual grants to a broad range of regional cultural organizations. In 2017, 58 grantees received \$2.4 Million in operating support. Since 1969, ArtsFund has awarded over **\$79.1 Million in grants** to over 100 organizations.

LEAD

Our grants and programs make cultural nonprofits stronger, more stable, and strategic. We also train the next generation of nonprofit leaders and arts advocates through our **Board Leadership Training, Cultural Partners Network, Convenings**, and other programs.

RESEARCH

Our **Social and Economic Impact Studies** provide critical advocacy tools for articulating the measurable impacts of the arts as regional economic and community drivers. We also administer the **Cultural Resource Collective**, a shared audience-building database.

ADVOCATE

We provide leadership and partner in promoting legislative initiatives such as **Building for the Arts**, raising awareness of critical civic issues and furthering public investment in arts and culture.

ENGAGE

We partner with civic, business, and public entities to **build healthy communities**, advance dialogue on the impact of the arts, and connect cultural partners with donors and patrons throughout the Central Puget Sound.
