## RELIEF

ArtsFund was one of the earliest to launch a relief fund helping to stabilize the sector with immediate relief for arts organizations negatively impacted by COVID-19. ArtsFund allocated \$3,152,500 in COVID-19 Arts Emergency Relief grant awards to 106 organizations throughout the Central Puget Sound Region.

## RECOVERY

As organizations strive to recover, ArtsFund's capacity building, leadership, and grant making programs are here for support. Following several listening sessions and countless one on one discussions with arts leaders and staff, ArtsFund has curated its 2020 programming in direct response to community needs.

## REIMAGINATION

ArtsFund is advancing the conversation and thinking boldly about how we might rebuild our arts and cultural sector around values of equity, sustainability, and innovation.

## What we do

### → GRANTMAKING

Donations are leveraged as annual grants to a broad range of regional cultural organizations. In 2020, 111 grantees received \$5.5 million in support.

### → LEADERSHIP

We train the next generation of nonprofit leaders, arts advocates, and philanthropists through our Board Leadership Training, Cultural Partners Network, ArtsFund Visionaries, and other programs.

### → ADVOCACY & ENGAGEMENT

We partner with civic, business, and public entities to advocate for the arts.

Our Social and Economic Impact Studies demonstrate the measurable impacts of arts as regional economic and community drivers.

We provide leadership and partner in promoting legislative initiatives such as Building for the Arts, furthering public investment in arts and culture.
