




ArtsFund supports the arts through leadership, advocacy, and grant making in order to build a healthy, equitable, and creative Washington.

WHAT WE DO

→ GRANT MAKING

Donations are leveraged as annual grants to a broad range of cultural organizations. In 2021, we partnered with the Washington State Chamber of Commerce to distribute Nonprofit Community Recovery grants on top of the \$2.2 million in general operating grants made possible by our generous donors. Since 1969, ArtsFund has awarded nearly \$100 million to over 650 arts and cultural organizations.

→ LEADERSHIP

We train the next generation of nonprofit leaders, arts advocates, and philanthropists through our Board Leadership Training, Cultural Partners Network, ArtsFund Visionaries, and other programs, uniting individuals who collectively shape the future of our arts community.

→ ADVOCACY & ENGAGEMENT

Our Social, Economic, and COVID Cultural Impact Studies demonstrate the measurable impacts of arts as regional economic and community drivers and track the impacts of the pandemic. We provide leadership and partner in promoting legislative initiatives such as Building for the Arts.

This work is approached with a deep commitment to fostering a more diverse, inclusive, and equitable arts sector.
