WHAT IS THE KITCHEN CABINET?

The Kitchen Cabinet is an advisory body for ArtsFund's Cultural Partners Network. This group of volunteers meets quarterly to inform and shape Cultural Partners Network programming and the network composition.

WHAT DOES A KITCHEN CABINET MEMBER DO?

You will be a key voice, helping to shape the network. You will:

- *Inform yearly programming* for the network including on trainings, convening topics, speakers, and other engagement activities
- *Advise the composition of the network* including recommending and providing feedback on new Cultural Partners
- *And more!*

WHO CAN VOLUNTEER FOR THE KITCHEN CABINET?

Kitchen Cabinet members must be staff at a Cultural Partner organization and be able to attend quarterly in-person and/or virtual meetings. We are looking for diverse perspectives from across the organization. You don't have to be in a leadership role at your organization to serve on the Kitchen Cabinet. Please share this opportunity with your colleagues.

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

The Kitchen Cabinet will meet four times a year virtually and/or in-person starting typically in February, May, August, and November*. Meetings will be approximately 90 minutes long.

WILL THERE BE A STIPEND FOR PARTICIPATION?

Yes, we value your perspective and time and are able to offer a small stipend contingent on meeting participation. Kitchen Cabinet members will receive \$75 per meeting.
